In consequence, this year's ISS will be exclusively held online and hosted by Tokyo University of Agriculture. This year's theme is "Linking Actions, Research and Education in Agricultural Value Chains to Achieve Environmental, Social and Economic Sustainability." We are pleased to invite two representative students from your esteemed university. Please kindly send the list of your selected representatives by **June 7th**, and ensure that each of them submits all the required application forms by **June 14th, 2021**.

One of the particular features of this year's ISS is the integration of a fifth sub-theme, "Nutrition." Since December 2020, Tokyo University of Agriculture has initiated a "Project-Based Collaborative Education Program Focusing on Nutrition Improvement in Africa," supported by the Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology (MEXT), in collaboration with our partners in Africa.

Another particularity of this year is the organization of a Pre-Summit which will be held online on **July 17th, 2021**. The aim of this event is to get the participating students be familiar with the use of the online tools which will be used during ISS and know each other before the event.
